Code of Conduct



Guilderton Golf Club Wedge Street Guilderton WA 6041 Guilderton Golf Club (GGC) is unlike most other golf clubs because of its location and relaxed atmosphere. But like all other clubs there are certain conditions that must be adhered to. The following are the behavioral standards that are expected of every member.

Code of Conduct

- Treat all other members and their guests and visitors to the Club fairly, equally and with respect. Refraining from any behaviours that belittle or bully or any form of harassing behaviour including sexual harassment.
- Play all competition golf within the rules as prescribed by the R&A, the local rules and any temporary local rules.

- Inform another player if you believe he or she is about to breach a rule.
 Disputed points should be noted and taken to the captain and not debated on course.
- Follow all recommendations and directions regarding pace of play and engage ready golf tactics should you fall behind the group in front.

- Conduct themselves with golf etiquette at all times during the round.
- Do not throw or break golf equipment (including golf balls) during a round.
- Do not use abusive or profane language towards another player, official or person during a round.
- Do not utter audible obscenities or sexual innuendos during a competition.
- Accompany their guests at all times; ensuring that their behaviour is appropriate.
- Children should remain with their carers who are responsible for their good behavior.
- Pets are to remain with their owners on leads at all times and not be allowed to interfere with other players.
- Problems with or complaints about other members or visitors should be reported to the Captain/Vice Captain (of the day) either verbally or in a written statement. Issue resolution to be in accordance with GGC constitution.
- Treat all Guilderton Country Club staff and officials with respect.

Resolution process for violations of the Code of Conduct

- When a breach of the Code of Conduct occurs, the Match Committee will consider what action needs to be taken and apply any penalty
- More serious or repeat offences will be referred to the GGC Committee who shall offer the member a chance to state their case.
- The GGC Committee will determine the appropriate action to take which may include a period of suspension or expulsion.
