


## WEDNESDAY NIGHT POOL COMPETITION



The atmosphere was friendly, fun and vibrant all night. Thanks to **Neil Adams**, whose music kept everyone dancing well into the early hours.



We're currently working on launching monthly cooking classes with Chef Clare, sharing her wonderful recipes and kitchen know how with our members and guests.








## Community Choir – What a Start to the Year




